

## VITA STATEWIDE NETWORK INFRASTRUCTURE CABLING CONTRACTS

[VITA's statewide cabling contracts](#), awarded in the first quarter of 2022 as a result of a competitive solicitation, provide competitive choices for Authorized Users to obtain standards-based network structured cabling systems, including in-building and outside plant, throughout the Commonwealth of Virginia. Contracts were awarded by "Service Districts" to ensure statewide availability, coverage, choice, and competition.

- Available for use by all public bodies, including VITA, as defined by Code § 2.2-4301 and referenced by Code §§ 2.2-4304 and 2.2-2012 ("Authorized Users"). Authorized Users include private institutions of higher education that are listed at <http://www.cicv.org/Our-Colleges/Profiles.aspx>.
- Provides all labor, supervision, tools, materials, equipment, and testing as may be required to install structured cabling systems in compliance with the TIA-568 "suite" of cabling standards (including any replacement/successor standards).
- Cabling system types include all current and future TIA-568-compliant cable types, including twisted-pair copper up to and including Category 6A; coaxial cable; and single- and multi-mode optical fiber cable; and any more-advanced cable types that may be ratified into the standards in the future.
- Multiple service providers awarded contracts in each of nine (9) "Service Districts" corresponding with the Virginia Department of Transportation's (VDOT's) "construction districts" (see below).
- Multiple Virginia Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity (SBSD) certified small, women- and minority-owned (SWaM) businesses, potentially including one or more "Micro Businesses," in each Service District.
- **VITA highly recommends that Authorized Users request quotes from multiple suppliers—**and the more, the better—serving their work location's service district to maximize competition. (See below for more information.)

### CABLING SERVICE CONTRACTS AWARDED BY SERVICE DISTRICT

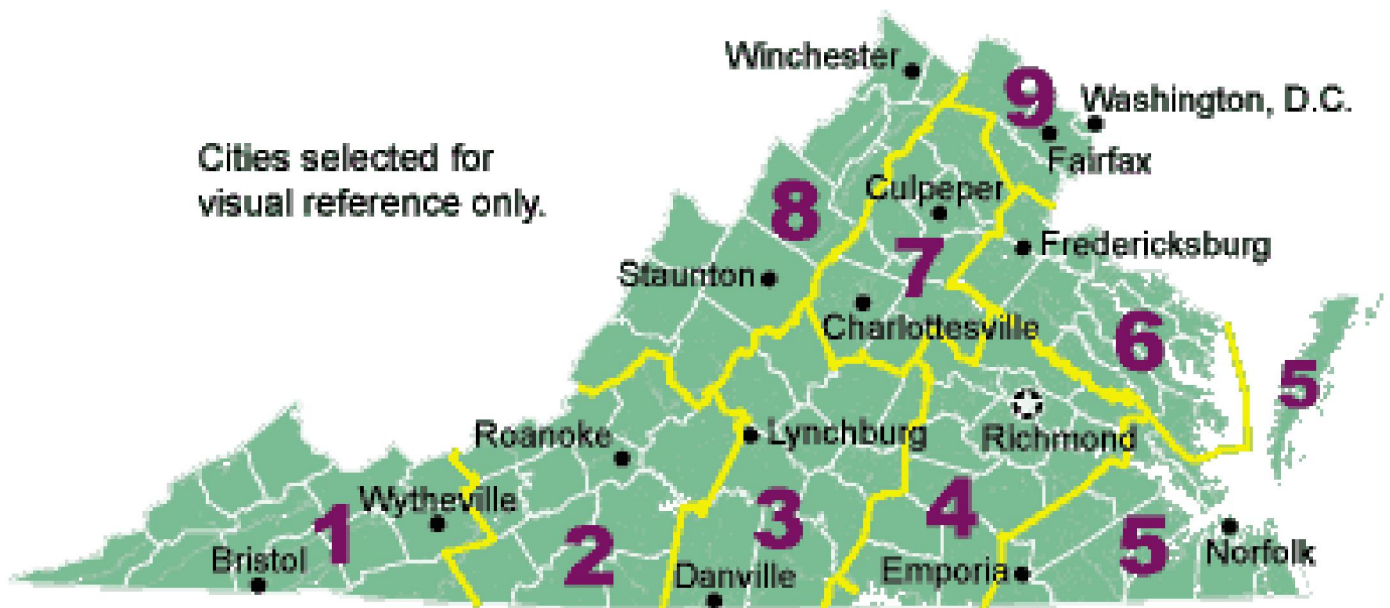
Contracts were awarded by "Service Districts" (corresponding with VDOT's "construction districts") to ensure statewide availability, coverage, choice, and competition.

search box, and click the “Search Records” button. The resulting list of contracts will only include those that offer services in the specified Service District. Some service providers have different offices serving each Service District, so **consult document “Exhibit D – Service Districts” for each contract, linked on each contract’s summary information page, to obtain the specific contact information for the desired Service District location.**
